Every 8 seconds a person dies of diabetes, in the same 8 seconds 2 develop the diabetes.

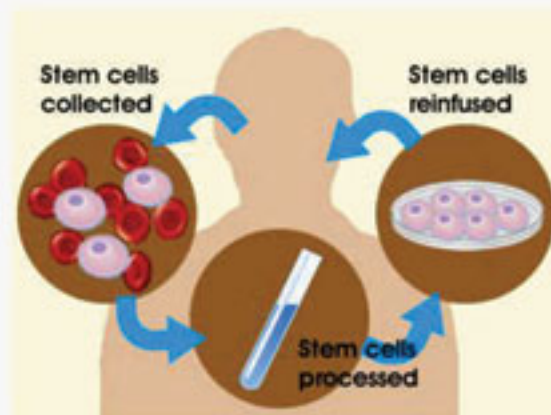
Stem Cell Therapy for Diabetes
